Gujarat Police
Act, 1951.

No.GG/84/2020/PWS/102008/1805/A:- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of section 5 of the Gujarat Police Act,1951 (Bom.XXIIth of 1951) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating the recruitment to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Wireless), Class I, in the Gujarat State Police Service, Gujarat State in the Police Wireless Organization of the Home Department, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Deputy Superintendent of Police (Wireless), Class I, in the Police Wireless Organization, Recruitment Rules, 2020.
2. Appointment to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Wireless), Class I, in the Gujarat State Police Service, Gujarat State in the Police Wireless Organization of the Home Department, shall be made either,-
 - (a) by promotion of a person who possesses “good” benchmark for being considered fit for promotion within the zone of consideration as laid down in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules,1967 from amongst the persons, who, -
 - (i) have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Police Inspector (Wireless), Class II, in the Gujarat State Police Service, in the Police Wireless Organization of the Home Department;
 - (ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006;

- (iii) have undergone the departmental training and field training at least three months under the supervision of the Director General of Police (Technical Services):

Provided that the person who has completed the training at the time of direct selection as Police Inspector (Wireless), Class II or Police Sub Inspector (Wireless), Class III or Technical Operator, Class III shall not be required to undergo such training again:

Provided further that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

- (b) by direct selection.

- 3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,—

- (A) not be more than 40 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services classification and Recruitment Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned,

- (B) (a) possess a post-graduate degree in Engineering/Technology in Electronics and Communication / Electronics and Telecommunication / Electronics / Information Technology /Information and Communication Technology/ Radio Engineering

/Computer Engineering/Computer Science obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; and

(i) have about three years experience on the post not below the rank of Police Sub-Inspector (Wireless), Class III, in the Police Wireless Organization, in the subordinate service of the Home Department; or

(ii) have about three years combined or separate experience in the field of Radio Engineering / Telecommunication / Electronics and Communication / Electronics / Maintenance of Wireless equipment in the Government / Local bodies / Government undertaking / Board / Corporation / Limited Company established under the Companies Act, 2013 on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Police Sub-Inspector (Wireless), Class III, in the Police Wireless Organization in the subordinate service of the Home Department; or

(b) possess a bachelor's degree in Engineering/Technology in Electronics and Communication / Electronics and Telecommunication / Electronics / Information Technology/ Information and Communication Technology/ Radio Engineering /Computer Engineering/Computer Science obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India or any other educational institutions recognized as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; and

(i) have about five years experience on the post not below the rank of Police Sub-Inspector (Wireless), Class III, in the Police Wireless Organization in the subordinate service of the Home Department; or

(ii) have about five years combined or separate experience in the field of Radio Engineering / Telecommunication / Electronics and Communication / Electronics / Maintenance of Wireless equipment in the Government / Local bodies / Government undertaking / Board / Corporation / Limited Company established under the Companies Act, 2013 on the post which can be considered equivalent to the post not below the rank of Police Sub-Inspector (Wireless), Class III , in the Police Wireless Organization in the subordinate service of the Home Department ;

(C) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967;

(D) possess the minimum requisite standard of physique as specified in Appendix-A annexed to these rules; and

(E) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to undergo police-training and to pass the police-training examination in accordance with the rules as may be prescribed by the Government.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to undergo pre-service training and to pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officer's Pre-Service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.

7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the

Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.

8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to undergo departmental training of three months and three months' field training under the supervision of the Director General of Police (Technical services).
9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
10. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall be required to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
11. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
12. Where in respect of any matter regarding service conditions of the Deputy Superintendent of Police (Wireless), Class I in the police Wireless Organization for which specific provision is not made either in Act or in these rules, the following rules as amended from time to time which are applicable to the employees of the corresponding class of Government of Gujarat, shall, *matatis-mutandis*, apply to the Deputy Superintendent of Police (Wireless), Class-I, in the police Wireless Organization to whom these rules are applicable namely:-
 1. The Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.
 2. The Gujarat Civil Services (Pay) Rules, 2002.
 3. The Gujarat Civil Services (Additions to Pay) Rules, 2002.
 4. The Gujarat Civil Services (General Conditions of Service) Rules, 2002.
 5. The Gujarat Civil Services (Travelling and Allowance) Rules, 2002.
 6. The Gujarat Civil Services (Occupation of Government Residential Accommodation) Rules, 2002.
 7. The Gujarat Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 2002.
 8. The Gujarat Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 2002.
