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No.GG/55/2009/MKM/102007/267(PT-III)/E-1: – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Superintendent of Prohibition and Excise, Class I, in the General State Service, in the Directorate of Prohibition and Excise, Gujarat State namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Superintendent of Prohibition and Excise, Class I, Recruitment Rules, 2012.

2. Appointment to the post of <u>Superintendent</u> of Prohibition and Excise, Class I, in the General State Service in the Directorate of Prohibition and Excise, Gujarat State, shall be made either -

 by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who -

(a) have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Superintendent of Prohibition and Excise, Class II, in the General State Service in the Directorate of Prohibition and Excise Gujarat State

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience as specified above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified above;

(b) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006; -

(c) have passed the prescribed Police Training Examination:

Provided that the Superintendent of Prohibition and Excise,Class II, who have passed once the requisite Police Training Examination as specified above, shall not require to pass the Police Training Examination again at the time of his promotion-;and

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(d) have fulfilled the minimum requisite standards of physical efficiency test, as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time, or

(2) by direct selection on the basis of the result of combined competitive examination held for the purpose in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services (Class I and II) Competitive Examination Rules 2000.

3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-

(a) not be more than 28 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(b) possess a degree obtained from any of the Universities or an institution established or incorporated by an Act of the Parliament or a State Legislature in India; or other educational Institution recognised as such or an institution declared to be cleemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; (3 of 1956) or possesses an equivalent qualification recognised as such by the Government;

(c) possess basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed by the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(d) possess the minimum requisite standards of physique as specified in **Appendix A** appended to these rules; and

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(e) possess the adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

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4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period , be required to,-

(i) undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officers' (Pre-service Training and Examination) Rules, 1970;

(ii) Undergo police training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the rules as may be prescribed by Government in that behalf; and

(iii) pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass the departmental examination, and an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by Government in that behalf.

7. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination in accoroance with the rules as may be prescribed by Government in that behalf.

8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such period and for such amount as may be prescribed by the Government in that behalf.
