Gujarat Police Act, 1951

No.GG/39/MTS/102010/806/V :- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause(b) of section 5 of the Gujarat Police Act, 1951 (Bom. XXII of 1951) and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Police Sub Inspector (Motor Transport) Class-III, in the Police Department, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Police Sub-Inspector (Motor Transport) Class-III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department, Recruitment Rules, 2015.

Appointment to the post of Police Sub-Inspector (Motor Transport) Class-III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department shall be made either;

- (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who;
 - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Head
 Constable Driver Mechanic, Grade I or Motor Vehicle Fitter, Grade
 I, or Store Keeper, or Motor Transport Supervisor Grade I, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Police Department in Motor
 Transport Division;
 - (ii) have passed the departmental examination as may be prescribed by the Government;.
 - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency 'Training and Examination' Rules, 2006; and
 - (iv) possess valid motor driving licence of heavy goods or heavy passenger vehicles at the time of promotion:

provided that the provision of sub-clause (iv) shall come into force after three years from the date of the commencement of this notification : Provided further that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. The appointments by promotion and by direct selection shall be made in the ratio of 1:1.

 To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule – 2, a candidate shall –

(a) not be more than 30 years of age :

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favor of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(b) possess -

 a bachelor's degree in Automobile Engineering or Mechanical Engineering of obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India or any other educational institution recognized as such or to be declared as a deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;

 the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

 valid motor driving licence of heavy goods or heavy passenger vehicles standing two years at the time of appointment;

(iv) the minimum requisite standard of physique as specified in Appendix- A appended to these rules;

(v) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

- Notwithstanding anything contained in any rules, a candidate selected by direct recruitment shall be appointed on contract basis for five years on such terms and conditions as prescribed in Government Resolution, Home Department No. MTS/102006/806/V dated 18/6/2015.
- A candidate appointed under rule 4 shall be given the prescribed pay scale of the post of Police Sub-Inspector (Motor Transport) Class-III after completion of contractual period on his performance being found satisfactory during the stipulated period of service on contract basis.
- A candidate appointed in accordance with ruled-4 shall, during the stipulated period of service on contractual basis, be required to pass the CCC examination for computer knowledge as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
- 8. A candidate appointed in accordance with ruled-4 shall, after regular appointment, be required to pass an examination of Hindi or Gujarati or both, as the case may be, in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
- 9. A candidate appointed by promotion or by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
- 10. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and a surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
