**Prisons  
Act, 1894.**

No. **GG-25/2016/JLM/502008/4970/J:-:-** In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to sub-section (10) of section 59 read with section 6 of Prisons Act, 1894 (9 of 1894), and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Superintendent, District Prisons/Open Prisons/Special Prisons, in the Gujarat Jail Service, class II, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Superintendent, District Prisons/ Open Prisons/ Special Prisons, Class II Recruitment Rules, 2016.
2. Appointment to the post of Superintendent, District Prisons/Open Prisons/ Special Prisons, in the Gujarat Jail Service, class II, shall be made either,-
  - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who,-
    - (i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Jailor Group I(Male) or Jailor Group I(Female), in the Gujarat Jail Service, Class II;
    - (ii) have passed the physical efficiency test as may be prescribed by the Government;
    - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above, or ,

(b) by direct selection.

3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, candidate shall,-

(a) not be more than 35 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes Socially and Economically Backward Classes, women in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment(General) Rules, 1967:

Provided further that the upper Age Limit may be relaxed in favour of a Candidate who is already in the Services of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment(General) Rules,1967;

(b) possess a bachelor degree of any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 or possess an equivalent qualification recognised by the Government;

(c) have fulfilled the requisite criteria of physical standards as prescribed in Appendix 'A' appended to these rules;

(d) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(e) have passed the physical efficiency test as prescribed by the Government;

(f) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.

4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period require to undergo pre-service training and to pass the post-training

examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officers Pre-Service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period require, to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, require to undergo police training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the rules as may be prescribed by the Government.
8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, require, to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
9. The candidate appointed either by promotion or by direct selection shall require to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
10. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and a surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
11. Where in respect of any matter regarding service conditions of the Superintendent, District Prisons/Open Prisons/Special Prisons, Class II for which specific provision is not made either in the Prisons Act, or in these rules, the following rules as amended from time to time which are applicable to the employees of the corresponding class of Government of Gujarat, shall, *matatis-mutandis*, apply to the Superintendent, District Prisons/Open Prisons/Special Prisons, Class II, whom these rules are applicable:

- (a) The Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.
- (b) The Gujarat Civil Services (Pay) Rules, 2002.
- (c) The Gujarat Civil Services (Additions to Pay) Rules, 2002.
- (d) The Gujarat Civil Services (General Conditions of Service) Rules, 2002.
- (e) The Gujarat Civil Services (Travelling Allowance) Rules, 2002.
- (f) The Gujarat Civil Services (Occupation of Government Residential Accommodation) Rules, 2002.
- (g) The Gujarat Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 2002.
- (h) The Gujarat Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 2002.

## Appendix 'A'

(See rule 3(c))

Minimum physical standards for the post of Superintendent, District Prisons/Open Prisons/ Special Prisons, Class II in the Jail Department.

Norms to be taken into consideration by the Medical Officer.

### **Physical Standard**

(A) All Male candidates shall be physically fit as per the standards for different classes of person as specified below:

Class	Height	Chest(Minimum*)		Weight
		Deflated	Inflated*	
Gurkha/other Hill Tribes of North, East and West India.	160 centimeters	79 centimeters	84 centimeters	50 kilogram.
Scheduled Tribes of Gujarat Origin.	160 centimeters	79 centimeters	84 centimeters	50 kilogram.
Others.	165 centimeters	79 centimeters	84 centimeters	50 kilogram.

\* Minimum expansion of chest when inflated shall not be less than 5 centimeters.

(B) All Female candidates shall be physically fit as per the standards for different classes of person as specified below:

Class	Height	Weight
Gurkha/other Hill Tribes of North, East and West India.	156 centimeters	45 kilogram.
Scheduled Tribes of Gujarat Origin.	156 centimeters	45 kilogram.
Others.	158 centimeters	45 kilogram.

(C) Candidates who have got any one or more of the following physical defects shall be considered physically unfit:


Knock Knee, Pigeon Chest, Squint Eye, Flat Feet, Varicose Veins, Hammer Toes, Fractured Limb, Decayed Teeth, Communicable / Skin Disease.

(D) SHAPEI Means

S	Psychological
H	Hearing
A	Appendage
P	Physical capacity for normal work
E	Eye sight
I	Mean fit in all respect to perform normal professional functions under each or the above mentioned heads

- (E) The candidate shall be free from surgical deformities like Knock-Knees, Flat-Foot and shall not have a past history of fits or Psychiatric Ailments, Varicose Vein, etc.
