Bombay Home Guards Act 1947. No.GS:45/20008/HGD/1099/3924/F:- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of Section 8 of the Bombay Home Guards Act,1947 the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Armourer ,Class-III, in the subordinate services of Home Guards Organisation, namely :-

- 1. These rules may be called the Armourer, Class-III, (Home Guards Organisation) Recruitment Rules, 2008.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Armourer, Class-III in the subordinate services of Home Guards Organisation shall be made
 - (i) by direct selection.

Or

- (ii) by direct selection from ex-servicemen or paramilitary force
- (a) To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall :-
 - (i) not be more than 25 years of age and
 - (ii) have passed the Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination from a secondary and / or Higher Secondary School Examination Board or possess an equivalent qualification recognised as such by the Government; and
 - (iii) possess the minimum requisite standard of physique as specified in Appendix-A annexed to these rules.
 - (iv) be a Home Guards Non-Commissioned Officer of Sergeant Rank and
 - (v) have successfully completed the State Level Armourer training course conducted by Commandant General, Home Guards and
 - (vi) possess a valid light motor vehicle driving license and
 - (vii) have about two years experience of driving as on the date of appointment and
 - (viii) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;and

(ix) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarat and/or Hindi.

or

To be eligible for appointment by direct selection from the exservicemen or paramilitary force, a candidate shall

- (i) have about fifteen years experience in the rank
 Sypoi / Police Constable (Armourer) in the Army or on the equivalent post in Air force or Navy or Border Security Force or Central Reserve Police Force or State Reserve Police Force; and
- (ii) not be more than 40 years of age and
- (iii) have passed :
 - (a) Indian Army Class-III Certificate of Education or possess an equivalent qualification; and
 - (b) Electrical or Mechanical Engineering Trade Test Class-III (Armourer) or possess an equivalent qualification; and
 - (c) Map Reading Standard-III Examination, and
- (iv) possess the minimum requisite standard of physique as specified in Appendix-A annexed to these rules; and
- (v) possess a valid light motor vehicle driving license and
- (vi) have about two years experience of driving as on the date of appointment and
- (vii) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967; and

(viii) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati and / or Hindi

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes or Socially and Educationally Backward Class or Women in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

Provided that the age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat , in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

- 4. The candidate appointed by direct selection will be kept on probation for a period of one year.
- 5. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be required to pass the qualifying examination for Computer Knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules 2006.
- 6. The selected candidate will be required to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government in that behalf from time to time.
- 7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and to pass such examination, as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
- A candidate appointed by direct selection will be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such period and for such amount as may be prescribed by the Government, from time to time.
