Constitution of India No.CG/ 2 /10/HGS/1091/363/F: In exercise of the Powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat, hereby makes the following rules, to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Senior Staff Officer, Class-I in the Home Guards organization Gujarat State namely:-

1//. These rules may be called the Senior Staff Officer, Class-I (Home Guards Organization) Recruitment Rules, 2010.

2//. Appointment to the Post of Senior Staff Officer, Class-I in the Home Guards Organization, Gujarat State shall be made either:

- (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the person who.
 - have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Junior Staff Officer, Class-II in the Home Guards Organization, and
 - have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006, and.
 - iii) possess a valid light motor vehicle driving license for a period of not less than two years as on the date of promotion.

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up a post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period, it may for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two thirds of the period specified in clause (i)**or**

- (b) by direct selection.or
- (c) by temporary transfer on deputation basis from amongst the person working on the cadre of Under Secretary in the Gujarat Secretariat service Class-I or any class-I officer of the State Government in the equivalent pay scale.

- 3//. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall :
 - a) not be more than 33 years of age
 - b) possess a second class degree obtained from any of the universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India or only other educational institution recognized as such or deemed to be a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 or possess an equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Government.
 - c) (i) have five years administrative experience on the post not below the rank of class-II officer in the Government or.
 - (ii) have five year's administrative experience in Local bodies or Government owned Board or Corporation or Government Undertaking or in a Company established by law in India or registered firm on the post equivalent to the Class-II post in the Government recognized as such by the Government. or
 - (iii) have five years experience in the Defence force as Commissioned officer holding the rank not lower than the rank of Major in army or its equivalent.
 - d) possess a valid light motor vehicle driving license and experience for a period of not less than two years as on the date of appointment.
 - e) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Service Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.
 - f) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both; and.
 - g) possess the minimum requisite standard of physique as specified in Appendix-A annexed to these rules.

Provide that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a person who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat civil services classification and recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

4//. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

- 5//. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be required to pass the qualifying examination for Computer knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Service Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules 2006.
- **6**//. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to undergo pre-service training and to pass the post training examination in accordance with the Gazetted officer's pre-service Training and Examination Rules 1970.
- 7//. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with rules prescribed by the Government in that behalf from time to time.
- 8//. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and to pass the examination as may be prescribed by the Government in that behalf from time to time.
- **9**//. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such period and for such amount as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
