No.GG/46/2017/HGD/102012/1089/F:- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of section 8 of the Gujarat Home Guards Act, 1947 (Bom. III of 1947), Government of Gujarat, hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Senior Staff Officer (Training) / Commandant, Class I in the General State Service in the Home Guards Organization, namely:-

- 1. These rules may be called the Senior Staff Officer (Training)/ Commandant, Class I (Home Guards Organization) Recruitment Rules, 2017.
- Appointment to the Post of Senior Staff Officer (Training)/ Commandant, Class
 I in the Home Guards Organization, shall be, made either;
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who,-
 - (i) have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Junior Staff Officer (Training)/ Centre Commander/ Staff Officer/ Inspector Instructor/Senior Instructor Class II in the General State Service in the Home Guards Organization,
 - (ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006; and
 - (iii) possess a valid light motor vehicle driving license for a period of not less than two years as on the date of promotion:

Provided, where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub clause (i) above;

or

(b) by direct selection from ex-servicemen;

or

(c) by temporary transfer on deputation basis from amongst the persons working on the cadre of Battalion Second in Command, Border wing

Gujarat Home Guards Act, 1947 Home Guards, Class I or on the cadre of Deputy Superintendent of Police in the Central Reserve Police Force or the State Reserve Police Force.

- **3.** To be eligible for appointment by direct selection from ex-servicemen to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-
 - (a) not be more than 47 years of age;
 - (b) possess a second class degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognised by the Government;
 - be a retired person as a regular Commissioned Officer of the rank of It Col in the army and its equivalent, in Air Force or Navy;
 - (d) have served pensionable service as a regular Commissioned officer in the armed forces;
 - have qualified in basic Young Officers Course (YO's) and qualified on Junior Command Course (JC Course);
 - (f) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967;
 - (g) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi; or both; and
 - (h) possess the minimum requisite standard of physique as specified in Appendix-A annexed to these rules;
 - (i) possess a valid light motor vehicle driving license for a period of not less than two years as on the date of appointment.
- The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
- 5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period shall be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
- 6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to undergo pre-service training and pass the post training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted officers pre-service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.
- 7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.

- 8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
- **9.** A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
